

The International SeaKeepers Society hosted Bal de la Mer 2016 to honor Alexander W. Dreyfoos.

Palm Beach, Florida – February 7th 2017 - The International SeaKeepers Society hosted Bal de la Mer 2016, to recognize SeaKeepers' Founding Member and Yachting Community Pioneer, Alexander W. Dreyfoos, for his extraordinary commitment to preserving our planet's oceans. The event was held at the Sailfish Club of Florida with the support of Dinner Chairs, Efrem "Skip" Zimbalist III & Paula Zimbalist. The special guest and award presenter of the evening was Fabien Cousteau, world renowned aquanaut and 2015 Bal de la Mer awardee.
