GLOBAL CHAPTERS



UNITED KINGDOM CHAPTER

In 2023, SeaKeepers established a chapter in the United Kingdom to oversee all regional programming. This initiative has facilitated connections with leading researchers, developed projects for vessels, and forged partnerships to advance environmental efforts.

SEAKEEPERS ASIA - SINGAPORE

In 2015, SeaKeepers established its first global chapter in Singapore, led by President Julian Chang and guided by Director of Programming, Gail Tay. The chapter focuses on education and citizen science, fostering community engagement and environmental awareness.

SEAKEEPERS ASIA - BANGLADESH

In 2023, SeaKeepers launched the Bangladesh Chapter to recognize the country's vital role in the global blue economy. Efforts will focus on preserving areas like the Bay of Bengal and the Sundarbans, underscoring the need for community involvement.

HEADQUARTERS

In 1998, The International SeaKeepers Society established its headquarters in Miami, Florida. Since then, its programming and operations have provided essential support to global chapters, advancing the organization's mission worldwide.

SOUTH PACIFIC CHAPTER

In 2023, SeaKeepers launched its newest chapter in New Zealand to oversee programming across the South Pacific region. The chapter has a diverse range of initiatives, from scientist-led expeditions to impactful educational efforts.

SOUTH PACIFIC CHAPTER

In 2023, SeaKeepers expanded into the South Pacific to support marine science and conservation by utilising privately owned yachts as platforms for oceanographic research, educational outreach, and marine conservation. SeaKeepers South Pacific offers scientist-led expeditions, citizen science initiatives, educational outreach, and community engagement projects.

Under the SeaKeepers' DISCOVERY Programme, yacht owners are invited to support marine research and conservation by offering time on their vessels or participating in Citizen Science projects. Our small but distinguished membership includes entrepreneurs, yachtsmen, corporations, divers, scientists, and concerned citizens, building a global movement to help restore and protect the world's oceans.









Since the expansion in 2023 the South Pacific Chapter has completed 9 Scientist-Led Expeditions, signed up over 30 vessels to participate in Citizen Science projects, created 7 new marina partnerships, hosted 1 floating classroom, created new partnerships, and engaged the community through conferences, speaking engagements, boat shows and many more events.
